

BURN-OFF SEASON IS HERE

With few being aware of their intentions, Ngulingah Aboriginal Land Council conducted a fuel reduction burn around Nimbin Rocks on the last Thursday of May.

Smoke from the cliffs above the Rocks, which could be seen for miles, raised concerns for the residents of Mountaintop as the fire crossed the Ngulingah boundary fences and was expected to burn for days.

Nimbin Rural Fire Brigade crews were up there extensively to ensure that there was no threat to any structure, but Deputy Captain Charlie Cohen said, "We had to do hours of chainsawing in a hurry, clearing alleged fire trails in order to be functional."

Land Council representatives were in attendance overnight and for the duration of the hazard reduction burns, which flared up spectacularly on the eastern side in a stiff breeze as night fell.

Fortunately the blazes were largely doused by a four-ml shower of rain later that evening.

Charlie Cohen said, "It's a good eye opener to you all: prepare for your own safety, be in charge of your own fuel.

"The weather is perfect for hazard reduction of every kind. Get off your ass and get busy. Don't whinge, talk to your neighbours and be effective together.

"Summer is not that far off – we have this opportunity where it is dry enough to slash or burn and set up for our collective safety."

It is a legal requirement to advise all adjoining neighbours 24 hours prior to lighting any fuel reduction burn and to contact the fire authority.
